

**THE FOLLOWING SUGGESTIONS HAVE BEEN TAKEN FROM TIM LaHAYE'S BOOK,  
HOW TO STUDY THE BIBLE FOR YOURSELF**

1. Write The Verse You Are Memorizing On 3" X 5" Cards.
2. Learn Your Verses By Topics.
3. Learn The Verse References.
4. Date And Record Each Verse.
5. Memorize Three Verses On One Topic Per Week.
6. Read The Verse Aloud And "Picture" It In Your Mind.
7. Review Daily For Seven Weeks:

The secret to lasting memorization is to review each verse daily for seven weeks. It has been discovered that if you do, then you can remove those verses to a once a week program for seven months, after which you can drop them into a once a month review for seven years. A handy way to arrange your verses for review is as follows:

- I. CURRENT DAILY PACK - not more than 21 verses divided into two groups.
  - A. 3 current verses on one topic - read out loud the topic, the reference, the verse, and the reference again five times each in the morning and five times in the evening. Do this for each verse for seven days.
  - B. 18 verses that you review once daily, quote the topic reference, verse, and reference again from memory every morning for the next six weeks.
- II. ONCE A WEEK PACK - after the seventh week of your program, you should add three new verses (one topic) to this pack each week.
- III. ONCE A MONTH PACK - after you have about 70-91 verses in your "once a week pack", you should add three new verses (one topic) a week to this pack.
